

Pain medication usage for inpatients listed for heart transplantation

Due to post-surgical concerns, pain medication usage should be actively minimized and used judiciously for all inpatients listed for heart transplantation.

A high usage of prn pain medications requires a thorough clinical assessment and should be actively minimized. Mechanical circulatory support devices (e.g. axillary Impella) is NOT an indication for long-acting pain medication and/or a high usage of prn pain medications after the initial 24-36 hours of device placement. Higher than expected pain medication usage should be brought to the attention of the transplant committee.
